

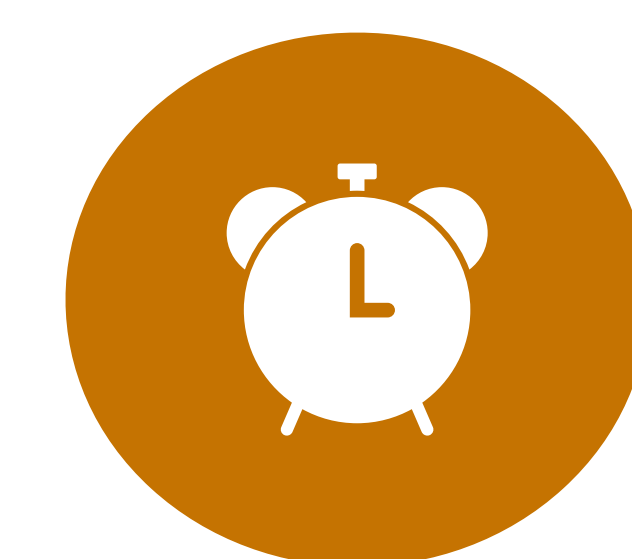

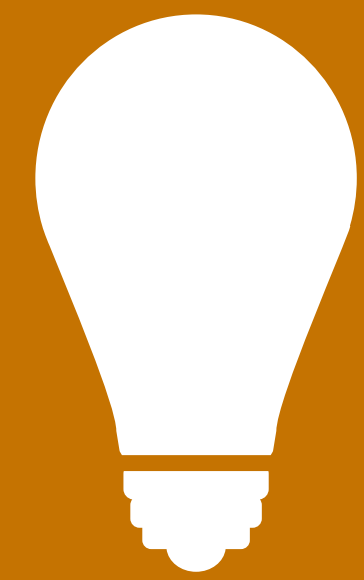

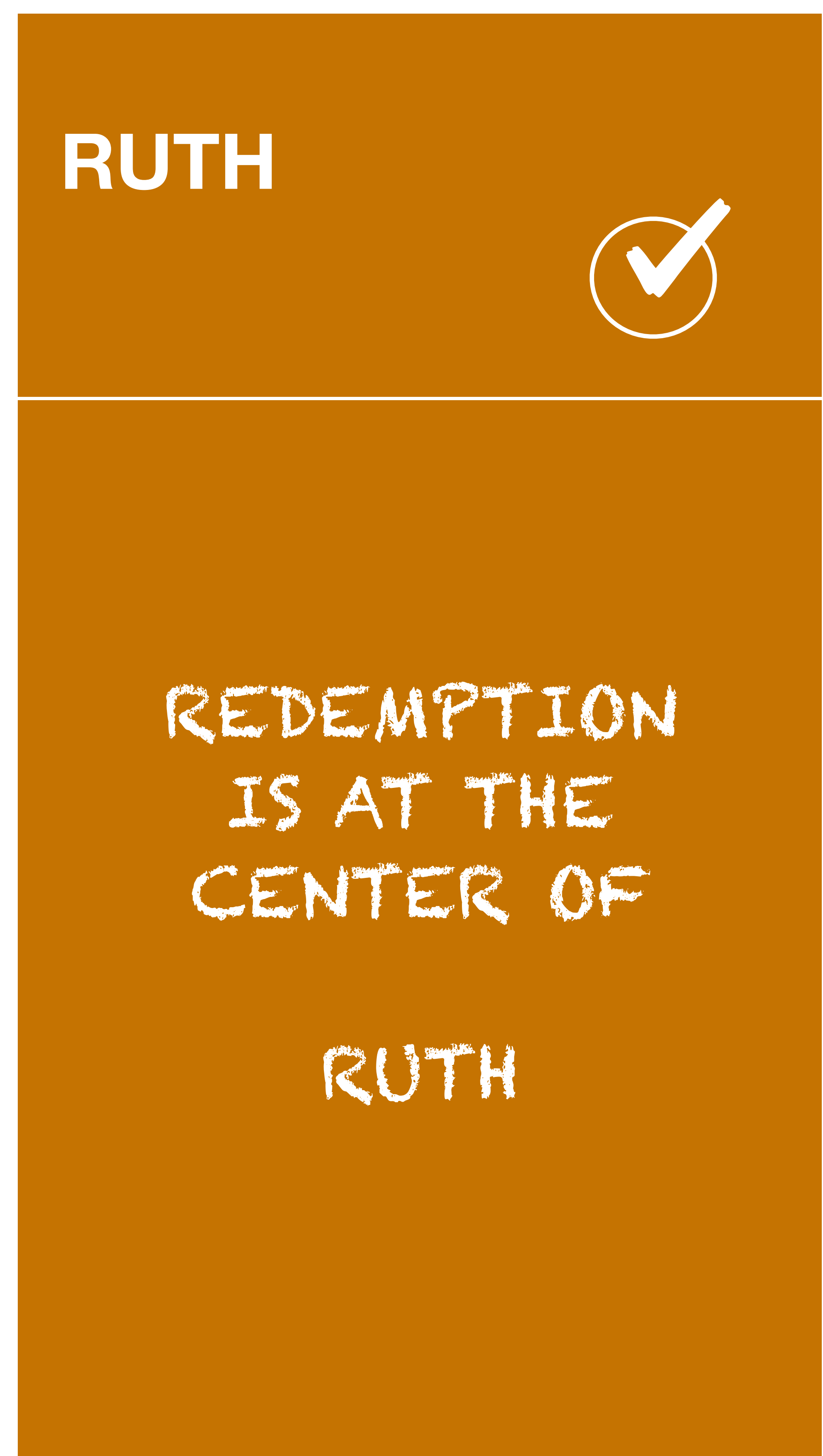


OVERVIEW
